

BSHI Equal Opportunities Policy Statement



The BSHI believes that people with different skills, background and experience can contribute to the society. The BSHI will actively promote equality of opportunity including positive race relations. No member or member applicant will be discriminated against or treated less favourably on the grounds of gender, race, colour, ethnic origin, marital status, disability, religion, sexual orientation or age (taking into account the Societies provisions on retirement). No member or member applicant shall be disadvantaged by any conditions or requirements related to Society membership which cannot be shown to be justifiable.

Any act of discrimination by any member or member applicant will be viewed seriously and may result in the refusal or cancellation of BSHI membership.

This Policy seeks to encourage all concerned to take positive steps to secure genuine equal membership opportunities within their sphere of responsibility.
