The following list sets out the types of articles that the newsletter team consider appropriate for publication in the BSHI newsletter, but, as always, we would welcome the views of readers.

- Review articles of current 'hot topics' or areas of ongoing interest
- Literature review articles, such as Science Watch
- Meeting or conference reports
- CPD information, including journal based learning scheme
- BSHI Business – reports from committee, sub-committees and working groups
- Notices for upcoming meetings or conferences
- Editorial articles by BSHI Corporate members on products or services which may be of interest to members
- Notices from members related to BSHI or H&I, of a non-time sensitive nature
