Vacancy Information:

BSHI Treasurer:

The Treasurer is one of the three Executive Officers for the BSHI. They oversee all financial transactions of BSHI alongside Executive Business Support (EBS). The primary duties include budget planning, financial reporting, record keeping, basic accounting, managing funds, handling invoices, and interacting with external companies. The Treasurer is required to participate in the Main Committee meetings. This is a demanding, yet important and rewarding position within the society. The successful individual is expected to be comfortable with numbers and have good record keeping practices. They will shadow the incumbent Treasurer until the end of their term at the AGM 2022 (December 2022), then take over the role fully afterwards. The Treasurer serves a 3-year period of office.

BSHI Main Committee Ordinary Member:

An enthusiastic BSHI member is encouraged to apply for this post which provides good experience of working on a national group as well as giving the satisfaction of helping your Society. You will be expected to attend three meetings a year and you may be requested to take on a specific role within the committee. The tenure for this post is three years.

BSHI Research Executive Ordinary Member:

The RE committee develops the scientific programme for the main BSHI annual meeting, arranges sessions at other meetings where BSHI input is requested, maintains links to the BSI and coordinates the Journal Based Learning. The tenure of this post is for three years and attendance would be expected at in-person and virtual meetings, as required. Nominations are invited from BSHI members who have an interest in the scientific direction of the Society and who are ideally active in R&D relating to H&I.

Nomination Process:

If you are interested in volunteering for any of the above vacancies, then please use the nomination form available on the website (link below) to submit your declaration of interest. This should include a short biographical profile (no more than 200 words), which will be shared with the membership if election is required. All nominations require the support of two current BSHI members and contact details for these individuals must be provided upon application.

Elections will be held (where there are ≥2 applicants for each post) following the specified closing date for nominations.

The closing date for applications is Monday 9th May 2022.
